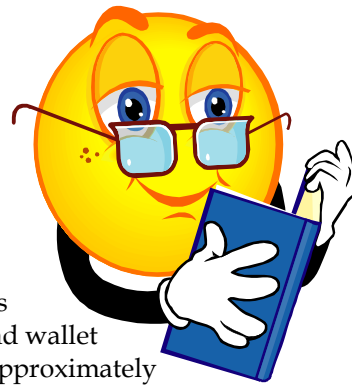


Operator Safety Training

Classes available include forklifts, self-propelled aerial work platforms or rough terrain telehandler forklifts. Courses are designed to instruct operators in the safe and proper use of their equipment. Instruction includes classroom training, hands-on operation of the equipment, various training materials, operator's training manual and refreshments. Certificates of Completion and wallet cards are provided for successful trainees. Operator classes last approximately 4-4½ hours. Cost: \$125 per person. Group discounts available for sessions conducted at our Franklin Park training center: 4-6 people - \$100/person; 7 or more people, \$85.00 per person.



"Train the Trainer" Programs

Available programs include forklifts, self-propelled aerial work platforms or rough terrain telehandlers. Programs are designed for safety directors, training managers, risk management personnel or the person responsible for operator training. The program includes classroom instruction covering a wide range of required topics and safety-related information, as well as hands-on operation of the equipment. Certificate of Completion, wallet card and other documentation is provided to successful trainees. Students receive a full complement of classroom-ready training materials with narrated PowerPoint® slide presentation on CD-ROM, training handouts, printable files for certificates and wallet cards, and training video. Each class lasts approximately 5-6 hours. Cost: \$695 per person.

Refresher Training Courses

Forklift operators must be re-evaluated at least once every three years. This program is designed to meet or exceed OSHA guidelines. The refresher course covers general safety, types of forklifts, stability issues, center of gravity, driving, load handling, battery charging and refueling. Each operator receives our exclusive "Operator's Pocket Guide to Safety" for powered industrial lift trucks. The program consists of classroom, written review quiz and driving test. OSHA requires the employer to evaluate the employee in their specific work environment using the specific lift truck they'll be operating. We provide new wallet cards along with evaluation sheets for the employer to use for this purpose. We offer a similar class for operators of aerial work platforms. Length of class: 2 hours Cost: per person: \$65.
